As Mathematicians we will be developing our understanding of:
Measure, angles, time, Addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, handling data and money.

As Writers we will be developing our sentence structure and our descriptive language through the genres of:

- Adventure stories
- Information reports
- Poems using imagery

As Readers we will be developing our use of comprehension, inference, selecting exciting words and phrases, and predicting what will happen next from clues we have read.

As Scientists we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be investigating the need for nutrition and the need for skeletons and muscles. We will also develop our understanding of forces including magnets.

In Computing, we will develop our research and formatting skills, by creating presentations and gathering data.

As Geographers we will be developing our understanding of key aspects of physical and human geography. We will be learning about different parts of the world and making comparisons.

As Artists and Designers we will be making energy bars in DT, making shelters to keep us safe and we will be learning how to make felt.
