Democracy

In art and design, we are aware of and consider the views and values of others, particularly when working collaboratively. We share opinions and have discussions when making decisions about our work, and collaborative projects. This is linked with the Bridgewater Value of 'Respect.'

Rule of Law

In art and design, we understand the school rules and values and recognise their importance in keeping ourselves and our peers safe. During projects and activities, we access tools and materials, making sure we are following class expectations. We know and understand the consequences of not following these expectations. We enjoy a calm, creative environment to express ourselves safely. This is linked with the Bridgewater Value of 'Responsibility.'

Individual Liberty

In art and design, we express our individuality and creativity using a variety of mediums. Our sketchbooks are a safe place to express ideas, explore techniques and make mistakes. Sketchbooks are not marked but provide a springboard for discussions, feedback with our teachers and creative growth. We have regular opportunities to make our own decisions and choices in our art projects and explorations. Whilst making our own choices, we also understand there are boundaries which must be respected. This is linked with the Bridgewater Values of 'Respect and Resilience.'

Mutual respect and tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs

In art and design, we behave in a way that positively impacts the work and productivity of others. When giving feedback, we are constructive and respectful of others' feelings and viewpoints. We work collaboratively on projects, have respect for our peers' views and are receptive to the advice of others. Ideas and techniques are shared between peers, and we appreciate that art is a subject that can be viewed differently by everyone. We also use art and design as a creative way to experience a variety of festivals and traditions. This is linked with the Bridgewater Value of 'Respect.'
