## **Bridgewater Primary School – Spelling Long Term Plan**

## Year 5

## Spelling Shed

Each lesson has a main objective from the National Curriculum appendix for spelling. The linguistic areas of phonology, orthography, morphology & etymology are included within the programme. Each lesson is designed as a number of modular components which can be taught as a single lesson per week or split into a number of sessions to be delivered over the course of a week (e.g. 1 hour lesson or 3 x 20 minute sessions). Each week a set of words is provided, these words are examples of the spelling pattern.

**Retrieval** - each lesson contains a revision section which should last approximately 5 minutes. Children will revisit sounds and spelling patterns from earlier weeks in the scheme.

**Introduction** - children will be acquainted with the words of the week. There will be an explanation of how the words are linked. The lists are organised by spelling patterns, sounds or affixes. This section is designed to take approximately 10 minutes.

**Main Teaching Input** - teachers and students will explore the words of the week. They will examine aspects such as the number of syllables, tricky sounds and the morphology of the words.

**Independent** – activities for pupils to complete with minimal instruction. Could be a home learning activity.

Consolidation - a recap of the objectives will be carried out.

**Challenge Weeks** - lists of words made up from the statutory word lists found in the National Curriculum English Programme of Study Spelling Appendix 2. An opportunity for children to put their learning into practise on words which may have unfamiliar or unusual spelling patterns.

**Homework** - online games designed to be used in school or at home. Teachers can assign word lists to each student so that they can practise them at home via our online games.
