



Year 2: Termly Forecast Spring 2022



Writing

As writers we will be expanding on our knowledge of grammar to create a non-chronological report about dragons. We will then build upon this to create a 'defeating the monster' story based on George and the Dragon.

In our poetry unit, we will be exploring the poem "the magical box" and creating our own poem based on what we would put into our boxes.

Mathematicians

As mathematicians, we will start to explore multiplication and division, where we introduce the \times and \div symbol. After that, we will look at statistics, shape and fractions.

Science

As scientists, we are exploring animals including humans. We will explore: animals and their offspring, basic needs of survival, healthy eating, hygiene and working scientifically.

Geography

As geographers, we will be learning about extreme weather, as well as exploring the United Kingdom, and each country within the UK, in detail. Our focus will be upon the human and physical features of each country before comparing them to each other.

History

As historians, we will be investigating changes over time. We will start by exploring Queen Victoria and her impact on society. Using this knowledge, we will then explore how toys and houses/homes have changed since the Victorian era. We will then investigate Northampton Castle and the Shoe Museum in our local area.

Art and Design

As artists, we will begin by exploring how Turner used hot and cold colours to create art based on the seaside. We will create sculptures based on surrealism to portray dreams. We will then build on our drawing/ painting skills by exploring Van Gogh and how he created his starry night. Finally, we will look at seascapes and the influence of Hokusai.

Music

As musicians, we are exploring dynamics and tempo. We will then focus upon how feelings are portrayed through music.

PHSE

As responsible citizens, we will reflect upon our dreams and goals. Subsequently, we will look at how to keep ourselves healthy and why this is important in our lives.

D & T

As design and technologists, we will learn about mechanisms with a focus on wheels and axles.

Physical Education

As learners in PE, we will develop our skills in gymnastics and using balls (focusing upon sending/ receiving). We will also focus upon how to keep ourselves healthy and that exercise is vital in achieving a healthy lifestyle.

RE

As respectful and reflective learners, we will explore the importance of praying for Muslims. We will then consider the topic of salvation in Christianity.
