Reading

As readers, we will continue to develop our inference, prediction, and summarising skills through analysing a range of texts such as Street Child and Charlotte's Web.

Writing

During our Autumn English work will use Ancient Greek myths as a focus to write play scripts then we will learn and write our own conquer the monster story using a range of writerly tools. Later in the term we will write non-fiction persuasive texts.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will be developing our knowledge of place value, calculation and fractions.

Science

As scientists, we will be learning about materials and their properties. We will analyse different materials and develop our enquiry skills to understand the process of how materials can change their state of matter from a solid, liquid or gas.

PSHE

As responsible citizens, we will be looking at our 'Being Me In My World' unit of work.

Art and Design

As artists and designers, we will be looking at our individual class artists and expressionism focussing on work that has been inspired from the greats.

D & T

As design and technologists, we will be experimenting with a variety of kneading techniques whilst making bread and experimenting with different materials and structures to make arches.

RE

As respectful and reflective learners, we will be developing and building upon our knowledge of Sikhism.

MFL

As Spanish speakers, we will practise and extend our descriptions about ourselves. We will explore school life, making comparisons with Bridgewater Primary. We will also continue to explore Spanish culture and traditions.

PE
