- Only use your first name when commenting – **no surnames**.
- Parents and carers who leave comments, please either use your first name only or post comments such as 'Molly's Mum' or 'Sam's Grandad'.
- Remember our online safety rules – don't reveal **any** personal information.
- Do not post photos from, or links to, other websites.
- Write in full sentences and read your posts back carefully; check and correct your spelling, grammar and punctuation before submitting.
- Be polite – don't post anything that could hurt anyone or that you wouldn't be happy to say to a teacher.
- Always show respect – be positive when commenting and always remember that the blog is an extension of our school that the rest of the world is able to see.
- All posts and comments are checked by school staff before they are approved.
